

## IBM Business Rules for IBM Cloud

### 1. Cloud Service Description

IBM Business Rules for IBM Cloud enables developers to minimize code changes by keeping business logic separate from application logic. The service provides the tooling to author business rules and the environment to deploy and execute the rule applications.

### 3. Entitlement and Billing Information

#### 3.1 Charge Metrics

The Cloud Service is available under the charge metric specified in the Transaction Document:

- **API Thousand Calls** – An API Call is the invocation of the Cloud Service via a programmatic interface. Client will be charged for the number of API Calls, rounded up to the next Thousand, during the billing period.

The API Calls measured by this Cloud Service are calls made to the rule execution engine to get a decision.

### 4. Enabling Software

The Cloud Service requires the use of enabling software that Client downloads to Client systems to facilitate use of the Cloud Service. Client may use enabling software only in connection with use of the Cloud Service. Enabling software included with the Cloud Service is IBM Rule Designer Eclipse plugin which may be used to develop decision applications.
