The Mobile Foundation cloud service deploys an advanced set of pre-built mobile services for users to accelerate and standardize mobile development and integration. The service also provides a console to manage the ongoing operations of mobile applications. Users can build mobile applications using their choice of front-end frameworks and tools, and standardize their approach for adding push notifications, authentication, offline sync, and business logic to their applications.

Application – An Application is a uniquely named software program. Client will be charged for each Application connected to or managed by the Cloud Service during the billing period.

Daily Client Device – A Client Device is a single user computing device or special purpose sensor or telemetry device that requests the execution of or receives for execution a set of commands, procedures, or applications from or provides data to another computer system that is typically referred to as a server or is otherwise managed by the server. Multiple Client Devices may share access to a common server. A Client Device may have some processing capability or be programmable to allow a user to do work. Client will be charged for the total number of Client Devices that run, provide data to, use services provided by, or otherwise access the Cloud Service for each day of the billing period.
