Oracle Instant Client 12cR2 now available for Linux on IBM Power Systems!

On June 07, 2017, Oracle made available for download the 12cR2 Instant Clients for use on Linux for Power supporting Little Endian mode. This is the most current Instant Client version in the Oracle support process, and can be used with the following versions of Red Hat Enterprise Linux (RHEL) and SUSE Linux:

- The Little Endian release is certified on RHEL 6 and 7.1 and SLES 12.

On Linux for Power these free, light-weight and easily installed Oracle Database libraries and SDKs are used for building and connecting client applications to remote Oracle Databases. Oracle Instant Client enables development and production deployment of Oracle Database applications. Support is provided for popular languages and environments including Node.js, Python and PHP, as well as providing access for OCI, OCCI, JDBC, ODBC and Pro*C applications.
