

Memorandum To: V5R4 iSeries Access Family Customers
Subject: Installation media for V5R4 and V6R1 System i Access Family products

The V5R4 iSeries Access Family includes the following installation media.

For installation on your i5/OS system:

The following is delivered with your V5R4 media:

- iSeries Access for Windows V5R4M0 (5722XE1), available on your i5/OS media with the standard set products, includes the primary and secondary languages versions specified on your order.
- iSeries Access for Web V5R4M0 (5722-XH2), available on your i5/OS media set with the keyed set products, includes the primary and secondary languages versions specified on your order.

If you have ordered the iSeries Access Family (5722-XW1) refresh (feature 2649), you will receive the following system media for the V6R1 System i Access Family products:

- A DVD entitled "IBM System i Access Family Refresh" (LCD8-0875-00). It contains the following products:
 - a) System i Access for Windows V6R1M0, installable from 51 national language versions.
 - b) System i Access for Web V6R1M0, installable from 51 national language versions.

For installation on your PC:

The following is delivered with your V5R4 media:

- V5R4 Setup and Operations CD-ROM (SK3T-4098-03), which includes the V5R4 iSeries Access for Windows PC code and the EZ-Setup wizard for setting up new systems.

If you have ordered the iSeries Access Family (5722-XW1) refresh (feature 2649), you will receive the following PC media:

- A two-DVD set with V6R1 System i Access for Windows PC code (SK5T-7096-00 and SK5T-7097-00). There are three installation images provided on this DVD set that are based on the type of processor for the PC. Refer to the installation instructions below.

The V5R4 and V6R1 System i Access for Windows setup information is provided in the i5/OS Information Center at <http://www.ibm.com/system/i/infocenter/>.

Here are installation instructions and product documentation for software that is delivered on the DVDs with refresh feature 2649 of 5722-XW1:

- **System i Access for Windows V6R1M0 (5761-XE1) – for installation on your PC:**
There are three installation images provided on the System i Access for Windows DVD set that are based on the type of processor for the PC: DVD 1 contains the 32-bit processor and 64-bit AMD processor images. DVD 2 contains the 64-bit Itanium® processor image. Select the DVD that contains the installation image for your PC, and insert it into the drive. There are two methods to start the install: cwblaunch.exe or setup.exe.

Determine which to use: cwblaunch.exe or setup.exe.

cwblaunch.exe

Cwblaunch.exe determines the processor in your PC and automatically starts the install using the correct installation image for your processor.

setup.exe

You need to know your processor type before using this option.

Determine your processor type:

1. Right-click My Computer and select Properties.
2. Your processor type is listed on the General tab.

For 32-bit processors and 64-bit AMD, insert DVD 1. For 64-bit Itanium processors, insert DVD 2.

To run **cwblaunch.exe**:

1. View the contents of the DVD in My Computer.
2. Double-click cwblaunch.exe
3. Use the wizard to complete the install.

To run **setup.exe**:

1. Determine which installation image to use, based on your PC processor type:
 - 32-bit is located on Disk 1 in Windows\Image32
 - 64-bit AMD is located on Disk 1 in Windows\Image64a
 - 64-bit Itanium is located on Disk 2 in Windows\Image64i
2. Run setup.exe in the correct installation image for your PC.

- **System i Access for Windows V6R1M0 (5761-XE1) – for installation on your i5/OS system.**

This licensed program may be installed on systems with either V5R4 or V6R1 i5/OS.

To install the licensed program on your system:

- a. Sign on to the i5/OS system with *SECOFR authority.
- b. Load the DVD entitled "IBM System i Access Family Refresh" on the installation device.
- c. Using OPT01 as an example for installation device, enter the following command:
RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5761XE1) DEV(OPT01) OPTION(*BASE)

If you are installing another language version, enter the following command:

```
RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5761XE1) DEV(OPT01) OPTION(*BASE) LNG(yyyy)
```

where "yyyy" is the national language version to restore.

For more detailed instructions on installing System i Access for Windows on your i5/OS system and on your PC, refer to the V6R1 i5/OS Information Center on the Web:

- **System i Access for Web V6R1M0 (5761-XH2) – for installation on your i5/OS system.**

This licensed program may be installed on systems with either V5R4 or V6R1 i5/OS.

BEFORE YOU INSTALL ANY VERSION OF SYSTEM I ACCESS FOR WEB: Please note that if you have a configured, running version of iSeries Access for Web currently on your i5/OS system, when you install a new release of the 5722-XH2 or 5761-XH2 licensed program, you are required to run the System i Access for Web configuration commands again in order to use the product.

To install the licensed program on your system:

- a. Sign on to the i5/OS system with *SECOFR authority.
- b. Load the DVD entitled "IBM System i Access Family Refresh" on the installation device.
- c. Using OPT01 as an example for installation device, enter the following command:
RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5761XH2) DEV(OPT01) OPTION(*BASE)

If you are installing another language version, enter the following command:

```
RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5761XH2) DEV(OPT01) OPTION(*BASE) LNG(yyyy)
```

where "yyyy" is the national language version to restore.
